

For the past four years, we have maintained this solemn display of flags to honor those lost in Iraq and Afghanistan.



The display today contains almost 5,000 flags.

Prospect Hill Cemetery and Cremation Gardens have protected and honored the graves and memories of American patriots since our founding in 1849. As York's most historic burial ground, we have sheltered the remains of veterans who have served in every conflict our nation has faced, beginning with the Revolutionary War. Philip Livingston, who died in York while attending the Continental Congress that met here was a signer of the Declaration of Independence.

Our commitment to honoring veterans has continued right through to the present day as we maintain one of York's most poignant memorials, the Iraq/Afghanistan Memorial Flag Display, containing almost 5,000 flags. Our development plans for **THE COURT OF VALOR** serves to continue our proud tradition of commemorating those who have served our nation so well.

At no cost, we will permanently inscribe this beautiful new monument with the names of those who were awarded valor medals by a grateful nation. This honor can be requested for veterans living or deceased and is not limited to those buried in our cemetery. A volunteer panel of veterans have developed the criteria under which this honor will be bestowed.
